Assisted Living Question Guide

Basic preliminary questions to ask during the initial phone call:

- Do you have apartments available now?
- What types of apartments do you have?
- What is the base rent charge and the pricing structure?
- What services are included in the monthly fee?
- Are there any move-in fees?
- Do you accept Medicaid?

*** If the community meets your timeline and fits the budget, try to schedule a tour with their marketing director. ***

Observations of community upon arrival:

- Is the community located in a desirable area?
- How close is the nearest hospital?
- Does the building appear to be maintained outside?
- Are the sidewalks/walking paths clear and level?
- Upon entering, are you greeted and welcomed by the staff?
- Are there offensive odors, or does it smell neutral/clean?
- Do the residents appear to be well-groomed and happy?
- Are the staff members kind toward the residents and each other?

Financial questions to ask during the tour:

- Are there any move-in promotions?
- Are there extra costs for additional services? If so, what are they?
- Do you require a minimum length of stay of private pay before qualifying for Medicaid rollover?
- What are the ancillary charges?
- What is the cost for Level of Care? (Or Ala Carte services?)

Staffing and care questions:

- What is the staff to resident ratio?
- What is the average response time when a call-button is pressed?
- Can the staff administer medication?
- What types of activities and events do you offer?
- Do you offer a variety of meal options?
- Do you have on-site health services? (Doctors, podiatrists, ophthalmologists, therapies?)
- Do you provide transportation?
- Are housekeeping and laundry services included, or provided at a separate charge?
- How does your staff respond to an emergency?
- What is your waitlist policy?
- Do you hold the apartment if a short-term hospital or skilled rehabilitation stay is necessary?
- What happens when I need additional services, or my loved one regresses?
- What is your philosophy of senior care?
